One accepted proposal in each category will be awarded a \$250.00 grant to be used toward their project. All grant winners will be asked to display project results/ progress at the 2009 Earth Day Celebration.

Proposal Requirements:

All grant proposals must include the following information.

1. Name, address, phone number, of contact person
2. Category/ Grade level
3. Description of the proposed project with objectives.
4. Description of how the community will benefit from this project if awarded.
5. Itemized budget
6. Additional information as needed
